FOREST RESOURCES: dynamics & politics



ESTONIA

- Forest land under pressure from infrastructure investments and nature restauration initiatives
- Protected forest area has been increasing rapidly past 5 years
- Growing stock has peaked and is in decline
- Proposal to set a target in Forest Law that at least 70% of forest must remain without limitations to managing in order to secure and stabilize wood availability
- Average harvesting volume 11 mln m³ stable

LATVIA

- Forest coverage and growing stock has peaked
- Discussion on lowering felling ages to increase wood availability
- Forest land under pressure from infrastructure investments and nature restauration initiatives
- Protected forest area has been increasing rapidly past 5 years
- Average harvesting volume 13 mln m³ growing

LITHUANIA


- Forest coverage and growing stock is increasing
- Average harvesting volume 8 mln m³


ESTONIA: COSUMPTION OF SAWN MATERIAL EXCEEDS LOCAL PRODUCTION

Diverse and well developed further processing of sawn wood










2021 vs 2024 volumes:

SAWMILL INVESTMENTS AND M&A



ESTONIA

- 3 sawmills closed in 2023
- Vara Sawmill investment, new sorting line. Production volume + 10-20%
- Toftan sawmill has been aquired by Estonian capiltal based Combiwood Group

LATVIA

- Rettenmeier new sawmill started operating with consumption of ~1 mln m³ of roundwood
- 2 sawmills aquired by HS Timber Group
